Students should bring: apron or paint smock, favorite detail brushes.

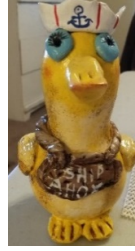

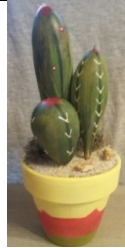
